Practical Application:

In processions you have often seen people carrying banners. This one here is for you to make and keep as your own. Cut on the heavy lines and fold on the dotted line. Punch holes in the two dots. (Teacher demonstrates.) The banner is completed. Ask your father to find you a nice long, thinstick. Put this stick in back of your banner through the two holes. Scotch tape will hold your handle so that you can carry it around just as people carry big banners in processions.
